Member

Individual

Award Criteria

Project

Provide details of:

Award Criteria

(i) Leader—Explain the leader/chairperson's approach to leadership, management style and avenues through which the team members were encouraged to actively participate in the project. Use examples to illustrate the practical application of the nominee's philosophies in areas such as goal setting, decision-making, delegation, communication, motivation and achieving deadlines.

(ii) Team Member—Explain the team member's approach to their role and involvement in the team in achieving the project goals. Use examples to illustrate the practical application of the nominee's attributes as a team player, in areas such as communication, following through on assignments, achieving deadlines, ability to envision project goals from the leader, influence on the motivation and energy of the team and ability to remain focused on achieving the desired outcomes.

(iii) Other eg. Consultant—*An individual who is not a member of the project team and who may or ma ynot be an AAPM member.*

Outline the high standard of contribution provided to the project by the individual in areas of expertise, introduction to contacts or other areas of assistance. Use practical illustrations to demonstrate how the contribution aided the success of the project. Additional materials maybe supplied to support the application

Committee/Team

Outline the nature and extent of the committee's contribution in envisioning the future of the healthcare industry and AAPM's role in this new dynamic environment. Outline how strategies were developed to strategically place AAPM in a position to meet the challenges of the future. Discuss the implementation of these strategies. Explain the approach the committee undertook in achieving the outcomes. Use practical illustrations to demonstrate the team process – such as innovation and creativity, communication processes, team member attributes, team decision making process, achieving deadlines and submission of recommendations to the state or national board. Provide documentation, reference letters and other material to support the application.

Non Member

Award Criteria

Explain how an individual, team, committee or corporation has supported AAPM in achieving the association's goals such as increasing membership, active promotion of the association or provided education and development programs. MERITORIOUS AWARD CATEGORY

Award Criteria

1. The nominee is a financial member of AAPM and has proven a commitment to AAPM that maybe considered to be ‘beyond the call of duty’.
2. The nominee has been actively involved in AAPM at a State and/or National level for a minimum of 5 years. The nominee’s involvement has been demonstrated through working committees, projects and seminars.
3. The nominee has demonstrated the advancement of AAPM in the health care industry either through envisioning changes to keep abreast of the dynamic health care environment or through involvement in the implementation process in achieving strategic goals

THE PROCESS
